## Questions

## 1. If the states are required to have our CSPR completed in December, is there a reason the snapshot is delayed?

Answer: The SY 2022 CSPR due date is February 28, 2024, and the MSIX snapshot date is January 13, 2024.

#### 2. Is there a time frame for summer or is just the enrollment type to be S?

Answer: The Summer/Intersession enrollment should occur during the performance period and the enrollment type should be 03. There should not be any overlap from one performance period to another.

#### 3. How/where is Enrollment Type 06 included?

Enrollment Type 06 is one of the enrollment types that can be associated with Category 1 children. Residency Only (OSY, Dropouts, or children not attending any school)

#### 4. How do you create "Snapshots" in MSIX?

Answer: We pull all the data out of MSIX at a certain time because MSIX is not a static database, we need to have one point in time as a reference.

A snapshot is an instantaneous "picture" of your server's file system at a certain period of time. This picture captures the contents of the entire file system when the snapshot was taken.

#### 5. Will the snapshot date change every year?

Answer: Yes, It depends upon the EDPass submission due date. MSIX takes the snapshot on Saturday just after the EDPass Submission Due date.

## 6. Will they (3-year-olds) appear on the Category 1 list because they turned 3, or because a P3 line was added in the state database?

Answer: They would be on the category 1 included list only if they turned 3 AND satisfy the category 1 child count logic related to residency.

Two years old turning three need to establish residency after they turn three years old. A residency verification date must be entered in your database after the child's third birthdate.

#### 7. What children appear on the Age Birth through 2 Included list?

Answer: Children appear on the Age Birth through 2 Included list if at least one of the following dates that establishes residency (Enrollment Date, Withdrawal Date, Residency Date, Residency Verification Date) occurs during the performance period and satisfies all of the following criteria: a. This date must occur on or after the child's Birth Date and the child does not turn 3 before the end of the performance period.b. The Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD) must occur on or before this date.c. The Eligibility Expiration Date must occur on or after this date.d. If a Graduation/HSE Date is submitted, it must occur on or after this date.e. Enrollment Type associated with this date must be 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, or 06.What children appear on the Age Birth through 2 Excluded list? The Age Birth through 2 Excluded list includes children who do not appear in the Age Birth through 2 Included list but who may be included in the State-generated Age Birth through 2 Child Count. States should match children appearing in their Age Birth through 2 count to children in the MSIX Age Birth through 2 Excluded list in order to examine reasons why these children have not been included in the MSIX count. Please note that this list should be used by States for comparison purposes only.

8. The PFS report says an enrollment within the PP, not a residency date or verification date or QAD. Is that correct? OME reframed the question.

What children appear on the Priority for Services Reconciliation Report?

Answer: Children are included in the MSIX PFS count if they meet all Category 1 Child Count eligibility requirements for the selected performance period, and they have at least one enrollment line in that performance period that includes a PFS Flag value of "Yes." If the child has multiple enrollments in the selected performance period with a PFS Flag value of "Yes" then MSIX will display the enrollment line with the longest duration (i.e. longest time between Enrollment Date and Withdrawal Date).

9. Can you drop the link here for EDPass submission due dates?

Answer: Communities360° - Home > Overview > Data Submission Organizer (ed.gov)

10. Where do States report any narratives as we did in the past for any increase/decrease greater than 10 percent from the previous year?

Answer: CSPR Part I question number 1.6.2.2 for category 1 and 1.6.3.2 for category 2 10% increase/decrease.

11. Additionally, where do we report reinterviewing and data quality narratives?

Answer: Qualitative data is submitted via the CSPR through Illume (new portal). Due dates for CSPR Part I Qualitative Data:

- a. First Submission Open/Close: January 31, 2024 to February 28, 2024 @ 5 pm ET
- b. Second Submission Open/Close: March 27, 2024 to April 17, 2024 @ 5pm ET

11. Where do States report any manual entry data like the number of students who graduated or received HSED?

Answer: Migratory student data concerning graduation and HSED are no longer collected by CSPR/EDFacts

- 12. What if there are Data Quality issues tied to EDPass reporting? Will we receive training from OME on how to review and resolve data issues? Referenced below is PSC guidance on how to handle any DQ issues, does OME create the comments in the DQ report spreadsheet that is submitted to States?
  - For example:
    - a. View all data quality comments in each tab of the DQ Report spreadsheet you received from PSC.
    - b. Resubmit data or metadata as needed to resolve data issues.
    - c. States are required to provide responses to data quality comments in each of the tabs of their DQ report.
- All guidance concerning data correction will come from the PSC.

### 13. When you report in your CSPR do you mean EDPass?

Answer: No, OME receives data via three portals.

- I. EDPass: For EdFacts File specifications (For example FS 121, FS 54, FS 145, FS 165, and shared file specifications)
- II. MSIX: For Child Count data
- III. CSPR: For qualitative data (For example Re-interview and 10 increase/decrease in child count compared to the prior year)
  - The Illume will be replaced with a new portal to submit qualitative data for SY 2022-23.
  - OME will inform the State Director after the confirmation of the new CSPR qualitative data submission portal.

## Where do I submit my subcategory data?

- SY 2022-23
  - State submits FS 121 via EDPass and MSIX
  - Pilot year to collect PFS, ELs, IDEA/IEP, and QAD via MSIX.
  - OME will compare EdFacts FS subcategory data with MSIX data to check data quality.

#### **Current Logic**

Children appear on the Category 1 Children Included list if one of the dates that establishes residency (Enrollment Date, Withdrawal Date, Residency Date, Residency Verification Date) occurs **during the performance period satisfies all of the following criteria:** 

- a) This date must occur **on or after** the child's 3rd birthday **and before** the child's 22nd birthday.
- b) The Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD) must occur **on or before** this date.
- c) The Eligibility Expiration Date must occur **on or after** this date.
- d) If a Graduation/HSE Date is submitted, it must occur **on or after** this date.
- e) Enrollment Type associated with this date must be 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, or 06.

#### **New Logic**

Children appear on the Category 1 Children Included list if one of the dates that establishes residency (Enrollment Date, Withdrawal Date, Residency Date, Residency Verification Date) occurs **during the performance period satisfies all of the following criteria:** 

- a) This date must occur **on or after** the child's 3rd birthday **and before** the child's 22nd birthday.
- b) The Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD) must occur **on or within 36 month minus one day before** this date.
- c) The Eligibility Expiration Date must occur **on or after** this date.
- d) If a Graduation/HSE Date is submitted, it must occur **on or after** this date.
- e) Enrollment Type associated with this date must be 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, or 06.

## **MSIX Category 2 Child Count Logic**

#### **Current Logic**

Children appear on the Category 2 Children Included list if they are included in the Category 1 Included list AND the date that establishes residency (Enrollment Date, Withdrawal Date, Residency Date, Residency Verification Date) occurs during the performance period and satisfies all of the following criteria:

- This date must occur on or after the child's 3rd birthday and before the child's 22nd birthday.
- b) The Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD) must occur **on or before** this date.
- c) The Eligibility Expiration Date must occur **on or after** this date.
- d) If a Graduation/HSE Date is submitted, it must occur **on or after** this date.
- e) Enrollment Type associated with this date must be 03 Summer/Intersession MEP-Funded Project.





## Age Birth through 2 Reconciliation Report | Access








